

# Automatic Data Update Facility

## 1. Introduction

The Auto update facility allows a mode of operation in which the data gets automatically updated, without the need to request the update.

This mode must be used with care as the transmission costs can be much higher than with the manual update mode. Also, some phone have an automatic "Sleep" or "Stand-by" mode that is entered when the user does not press a key on the phone for a certain time. This is not configurable on all the phones.

To protect users from costly errors, the Auto update facility require a permission code to be activated.

This code is only supplied to the user if the owner of the subscription contract allows it.

## 2. Activation of the Auto Update Facility

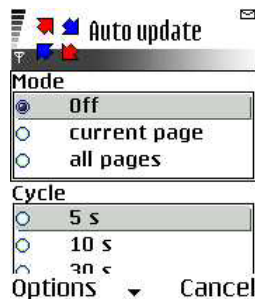
### 2.1 Authorize the Facility

From the application "Top Menu", select "Registration", Move down to the "Auto Update Code" entry line and enter the provided code. Validate through "Options -> OK".



### 2.2 Activate and set-up the Facility

From the application "Top Menu", select "Auto Updates", the following is displayed:

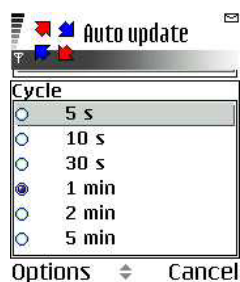


Select the automatic updating of only the currently displayed page or all the pages.

To switch Off the Auto update, select "Off".

Note that when you Close and restart the application, you have to reactivate the Auto Update.

### Set the Update Cycle Time



Go one step down and select the update cycle time (an update rate of 5 sec can be very costly!)

**Set the Duration of the Auto Update Mode**



Go one step down and select the number of hours the Auto Update mode must remain active (from 1 to 10 hours). After this time, the Auto Update mode will be automatically deactivated. This is a protection in case the user forgets to deactivate. Validate all the above settings through “Options -> OK”.

**3. Auto Update Indication**

When the Auto Update is active, this is indicated on the data display page with a red “A”



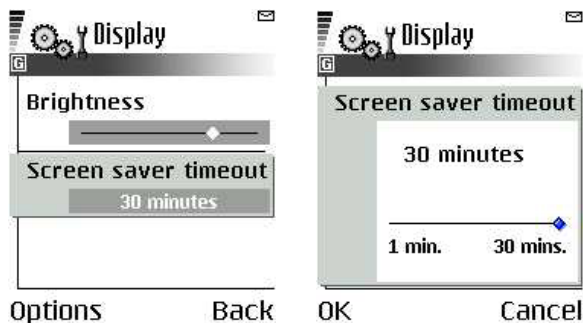
**4. Phone Settings**

In order to take best advantage of the Auto Update facility, the phone should be set-up such that it does not stop the updating process or at least not too soon.

As an example, this is the setting that should be selected for the Nokia 3650, 6600 and 7650 phones:

From the phone main menu, go to “Tools -> Settings -> Phone -> Display -> Screen saver timeout”. Select the longest time possible (in this case 30 min).

After 30 min, the phone will go into “Sleep mode” and the auto update will stop. To restart it press any key.



Other phones have different possibilities, some even allowing permanent operation.
